2. Things that you need to consider when you are taking shooting.

A: Students need to remind the speech time duration and try to keep it on time.

(Aides can provide the signal at **15 seconds** before ending the speech)

B: Students can use a **cue card**, but try not looking at it all the time.

C: Teachers can allow **3 mins** preparation time before shooting.

D: Maximum shooting opportunity is 3 times on site when you are shooting.
