A: jiugae isseoyo	A: Do you have an eraser?	A: 지우개 있어요?
B: ne jiugae isseoyo	B: Yes, I have an eraser.	B: 네, 지우개 있어요.

### Model Conversation 2

Romanisation	English	Korean
A: ja isseoyo	A: Do you have a ruler?	A: 자 있어요?
B: aniyo ja eopseoyo	B: No, I don't have a ruler.	B: 아니요, 자 없어요.

### Processes/Activities/Strategies

#### • New vocabs (1\_U9P1)

- Repeat the new vocabularies and the names of different objects in Korean with teacher.
- Note that the sentence can become a question just by raising a voice at the end.

#### • Conversation (1\_U9P1)

- Students practice Model Conversation 1 and 2.

#### • Let's write

- Write letters in Korean. (1\_U9A1)

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• **Let's play** - Omok, Connect 5 (1\_U9A2)

• **Extension activity**

- Match the Card (1\_U9E1a), (1\_U9E1b)

1. Hand out the picture cards (1\_U9E1a), (1\_U9E1b) to groups of 3~4 students.
2. Put the cards face down.
3. Each student will take turns to turn over two cards.
4. If the student finds the correct pair (picture and word), he/she will keep the pair and have another turn.
5. If the student don't find the correct pair, the cards are turned face down and the next student will have a turn.
6. Repeat the process until all of the pairs have been found.

## Let's play – Omok (Connect 5)

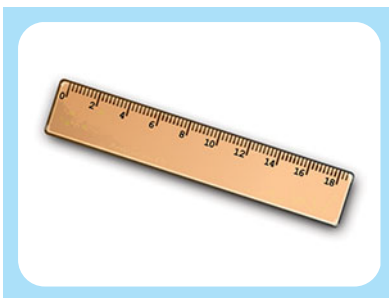
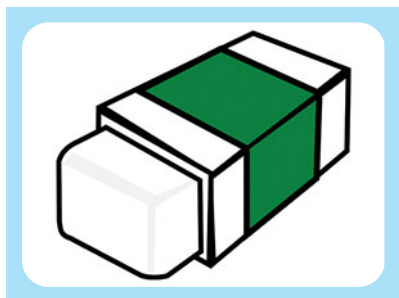
- Two Players
